1. Be in seat when bell rings.


2. Use restroom between classes. 3. Bring all of your supplies to class daily.

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LATE / INCOMPLETE WORK (-)

* My expectation is that **ALL** assignments be completed with excellence and turned in on time. If an assignment is turned in but has not been **completed**, the assignment will be returned to the student and the work must be completed / redone. The assignment will not receive a grade until it has been satisfactorily completed.

* Parents will be contacted by Renweb every time an assignment is late or receives lower than a 70%. **One demerit** will be issued for every three late or incomplete assignments.

* Printer and Internet issues are not an excuse for late work.

ABSENTEE POLICY

* YES, WE DID SOMETHING WHILE YOU WERE ABSENT, and YES, IT WAS IMPORTANT. It is the student's responsibility to check the class folder, clipboard, Renweb, or phone a friend to find any assignments, homework, and notes missed. * A student has <u>nvo</u> extra days to turn in any work *assigned* on a day a student was absent. BUT if an assignment was DUE on the day the student was absent, the assignment must be turned in or made up on the first day the student returns.
